Notice of Race

35th Annual Goblin Regatta

October 27th & 28th, 2007

1. Host and Organizing Authority

The regatta is hosted and organized by the Santa Barbara Sailing Club.

2. Rules

This regatta will be governed by the 'rules' as defined in the Racing Rules of Sailing 2005-2008 (RRS), the prescriptions of US Sailing, the rules of the participating classes, this Notice of Race (except as any of these are altered by the Sailing Instructions) and the Sailing Instructions.

3. Eligibility

Classes invited to compete are all One Design and PHRF fleets with at least three or more entries. Entrants must be current members in good standing in their respective class. PHRF handicap ratings will be applied per PHRF certificate or by listing if not certified.

4. Entry

Competitors may enter by filling out and returning a completed entry form and paying applicable fees (\$15 for Lasers, \$20 for boats under 20 feet, all others \$30, an additional \$5 dollar charge will be levied for on-site registration). Entry forms for early registration may be found under the SBSC "Events" web page (www.sailsbsc.org) beginning October 10th.

5. Schedule of Events

Registration and Skippers Meeting will be held in the Santa Barbara Sailing Club yard.

6. Sailing Instructions

Sailing instructions in draft version will be available at www.sailsbsc.org on or around October 23rd. The final version of the sailing instructions will be available at registration.

7. Scoring

The low-point scoring system of Appendix A will apply. For all classes as many races as possible are scheduled in the series. When eight or more races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores excluding her worst score. One race must be completed to constitute a series.

8. Racing Area and Course

The races will be held approximately one-half nautical mile southwest of the entrance to the Santa Barbara harbor. The course(s) to be sailed will be windward leeward and variations thereof as described in the Sailing Instructions.

9. Prizes

Trophies will be awarded to the top three boats in each class. A prize will also be given to the best costume.

10. Mooring and Boat Storage

Boat and trailer storage will be made available on a first come basis beginning Friday October 27th at 16:30. Mooring is also available on a first come first serve basis in the Santa Barbara Harbor. Slip fees may apply.
