NOTICE OF RACE

27th ANNUAL **HARDWAY RACE**

1st Race of the Land Rover Island Series

SANTA BARBARA TO VENTURA HARBOR

The Hardway (around Santa Cruz) or Coastwise (inshore)

First, second and third place trophies will be awarded in each class

Race will be governed by the *rules* as defined in the *Racing Rules of Sailing*

THE HARDWAY

(Around Santa Cruz Island, 67 nm)

Category 3 equipment and PHRF membership required. Classes will be formed according to number of entries. (Area A handicap, random leg).

COASTWISE NON-SPIN & BEACH CAT

(Around platforms C, Habitat, and Grace, 29 nm)

Category 3 equipment required. A minimum of 2 crew members, including skipper. PHRF membership not required. Race Committee will assign a handicap to those boats that are not rated. (Area A handicap, random leg).

MULTI-HULL

(Around Anacapa Island, 47 nm)

ORCA TCF ratings will be used. Safety equipment as specified by ORCA.

COASTWISE SPINNAKER

(Around mid-channel NOAA buoy and Grace, 43 nm)

Category 3 equipment and PHRF membership required. (Area A handicap, random leg).

HARDWAY CLUB CHAMPIONSHIP TROPHY

The corrected times of the first 3 boats from each club that sailed the Hardway Race around Santa Cruz will be totaled and the club with the lowest aggregate total time will be awarded the Hardway Race Club Championship trophy.

HARDWAY RACE OVERALL WINNER TROPHY

A perpetual trophy will be awarded to the skipper of the boat with the lowest corrected time among all PHRF classes sailing the Hardway course.

HARDWAY RACE FIRST TO FINISH TROPHY

A perpetual trophy will be awarded to the first boat to finish the Hardway Race around Santa Cruz.

COASTWISE NON-SPINNAKER PERPETUAL TROPHY

A perpetual trophy will be awarded to the skipper of the boat with the lowest corrected time among all boats sailing the Coastwise Non-Spinnaker course.

COASTWISE SPINNAKER PERPETUAL TROPHY

A perpetual trophy will be awarded to the skipper of the boat with the lowest corrected time among all boats sailing the Coastwise Spinnaker course.
