Notice of Race

Bugay Single Handed Race - Saturday October 10th, 2009

1 Host and Organizing Authority

The regatta is hosted and organized by the Santa Barbara Sailing Club.

2 Rules

This race will be governed by the 'rules' as defined in the Racing Rules of Sailing 2009-2010 (RRS), the prescriptions of US Sailing, PHRF-SoCal class rules, this Notice of Race (except as any of these are altered by the Sailing Instructions) and the Sailing Instructions. This race is a single-handed race, this modifies rule 10.5 of the PHRF-SoCal Class Rules. Area A1 PHRF ratings apply to all competitors.

3 Eligibility and Entry

All PHRF yachts are eligible. Handicap ratings will be applied per PHRF certificate or by listing if not certified. Area Random Leg PHRF handicaps will be used. . PHRF handicap ratings will be applied per PHRF certificate or by listing if not certified. Valid rating certificate must be presented, or on file with SBSC. Entrants must be current members in good standing in their respective class, and members of a recognized sailing club or yacht club.

This race is a single-handed race and therefore it is highly recommended that the single-handed entry have experience in all aspects of seamanship.

There is a \$15 entry fee.

4 External assistance

No outside help whatsoever is allowed from the time each boat leaves the dock until it returns.

5 Safety equipment

This is a PHRF Category 4 event. All boats shall carry the equipment specified by PHRF for Category 4 races.

6 Schedule of Events

All activities will take place on Saturday, October 10th, 2009. Registration will be held between the hours of 0800 and 1000 hours at the Santa Barbara Sailing Club clubhouse. A skippers meeting will be held at the clubhouse at 1000 hours. The warning for the start of the race will be at 1125 hours. A social event will be held after the race starting at approximately 1500 hours.

7 Sailing Instructions

Sailing instructions will be available at www.sailsbsc.org and at registration.

8 Racing Area and Course

The race will be held off the waters of Santa Barbara. The race will start approximately one-half nautical mile southwest of the entrance to the Santa Barbara harbor. Further course detail will be described in the Sailing Instructions.

9 Prizes

Trophies will be awarded to the top three finishers. The winning skipper will also have their name engraved on the Santa Barbara Sailing Club "Bugay Single Handed" Perpetual Trophy.

10 Mooring

Mooring is available on a first come first served basis in the Santa Barbara Harbor. Fees apply.
